Workshop	Chinese Brush Painting
Details	This session will begin with a brief history of Chinese art and the main ways it differs from Western painting styles. This will be followed by a demonstration of brush technique and posture, and then the first exercise for the children to practise, finishing in painting a long flowing orchid stem, adding simple orchid flowers. The second exercise teaches more techniques to do with ink and dilution, and adding watercolour, by painting the remaining "Four Gentlemen" - four plants used to teach the fundamental elements of Chinese brush painting: the plum blossom (梅), the bamboo (竹), and the chrysanthemum (菊). (The other plant is the orchid (蘭) which we used as a model in Exercise 1.) These all represent different things in Chinese culture: e.g. strength, peace, purity etc. The session finishes with children choosing and painting their own Chinese-inspired picture – trees, landscapes, birds, etc.
